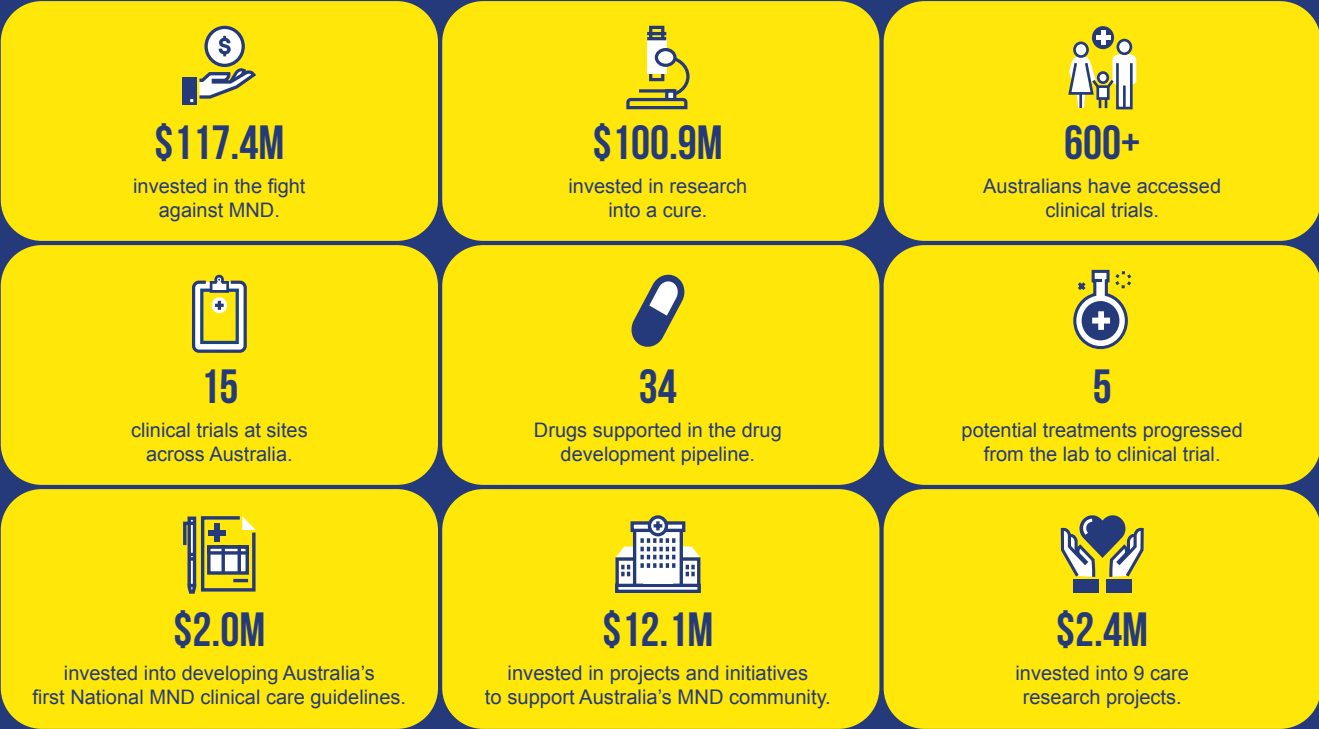


YOUR IMPACT

MORNING BRIEFINGS

There will be a 30-minute briefing every morning at breakfast. At least one member of each team must attend the briefing. Preferably the first designated driver for the day.

The morning briefing includes information about:

- any changes to the itinerary
- expected arrival and departure time for each stop
- known roadworks and delays on the route
- community events
- any team requirements before arriving at the night location.

All drivers will be breathalysed each morning before the end of breakfast. Please allow enough time to complete this process so we can get everyone on the road safely and on schedule.

DIRECT COMMUNICATIONS

The Drive Committee will communicate key and time sensitive information via WhatsApp. There may be occasions where the Committee will communicate information to Team Captains only.



BEHAVIOUR ON THE DRIVE + REPORTING AN INCIDENT

Daniher's Drive is one of FightMND's most significant fundraising and public events. As we prepare for this year's Drive, we kindly remind all participants to review and adhere to the expected behaviours outlined in our Terms and Conditions.

Your cooperation ensures a safe, respectful, and successful event for everyone involved.

Team Captains, we're relying on you to champion these behaviours within your team. At FightMND we're appreciative of your support and contribution to this year's Drive. We want to make these four days memorable for you and enjoyable for everyone meeting us along the way. To ensure this, we must be mindful of our behaviour in the wider community.

As a Daniher's Drive participant, you are representing and championing FightMND. Throughout the Drive you'll wear the FightMND brand with your polo, cap, car decals and other materials. At all times participants must be aware that you are an ambassador for FightMND and adhere to this Risk and Responsible Behaviour Policy. Failure to do so may result in your removal from Daniher's Drive.

Represent the FightMND brand

As a participant, you are an ambassador for FightMND and Daniher's Drive. Please always act ethically, responsibly and with respect.

Uphold FightMND values.

All participants agree to align and uphold the FightMND values of urgency, integrity, efficiency, boldness and community.

Respect each other and local communities.

Always maintain and exhibit mutual respect for local communities, Drive participants, volunteers and FightMND staff. We work to ensure Daniher's Drive is an event free from bullying, harassment and discrimination. All participants agree to immediately report any incident, either experienced or witnessed, to the nominated FightMND incident manager.

Avoid excessive alcohol consumption.

All drivers must obey all VicRoads alcohol, safety and speed protocols. Participants must refrain from drinking alcohol in public premises or unlicensed venues. Licensed venues will adhere to Responsible Service of Alcohol requirements. You may be asked to leave the premises if you do not follow the venue's requirements.

We kindly ask that you avoid the excess consumption of alcohol throughout the Drive and adhere to all Responsible Service of Alcohol requirements.

Strict no drugs policy.

Avoid any illicit substance use across Daniher's Drive.

Share your experience.

We encourage you to share your Daniher's Drive story, photos and videos with the world. But we do kindly ask that all posts are respectful and appropriate. Content including, but not limited to, nudity, swearing, racism, homophobia, sexually explicit language, abusive language, unsafe driving practices, language condoning or encouraging illegal practices or otherwise unacceptable wording/content will be removed.

VEHICLE AND DRIVER REQUIREMENTS

Your vehicle must meet road safety standards and be checked thoroughly before the start of the Drive.

- Each team must have at least one member with roadside assistance cover.
- Each team is responsible for their vehicle repairs during the Drive. Please note that common parts may not be available in every area that the Drive route goes through. Teams should consider carrying any mechanical items that are specific to your vehicle.
- Anyone driving during Daniher's Drive must have blood alcohol reading under 0.05. Drivers on a provisional licence must have a blood alcohol reading of 0.
- The Drive will travel through areas with little, or no, mobile phone signal. We strongly recommend that each team has at least one Telstra mobile.

FUNDRAISING

Participants must meet the minimum fundraising targets before the start of the Drive on 9 October. For teams of up to four people the minimum fundraising target is \$5,000. Teams with more than four people must fundraise an additional \$1,500 per team member.

EVENT ROUTE AND DRIVING RULES

Daniher's Drive is not a race or a time trial. All road rules apply and speed limits must be obeyed at all times.

The Drive course has been set by the Drive Committee. It does not take the most direct route between destinations. But that's part of the fun! We look forward to taking the scenic route with you all.
